Quantum physics has drastically changed our view of ourselves and the world around. Through technology, films and even video games we are being presented with these thought provoking possibilities. Bradley Bartholomew's new book The Spiritual Genome; Networked Intelligence in DNA; stretches the fabric of such concepts perhaps taking our minds further than we could have ever imagined. The author blends together, science, spirituality, philosophy and history piloting us into an evolutionary age.

Bradley Bartholomew started writing this book in the mid-1980s - almost 30 years ago. He started reading the works of Sigmund Freud and became so fascinated that he ended up twice reading Freud's complete works (3 million words). He then had an epiphany - a profound realization that Freud's unconscious mind and the Inner Self are one and the same. At that stage he had only a profound 'feeling' that the Inner Self of all sentient beings was somehow connected at the base of the brain which enabled us all to see an illusory external world.

This book examines theories that within the networked intelligence in the DNA, there are memristors in the DNA that enable the storing and processing of data and that the DNA acts as an optical quantum computer which transmits its instructions to the brain/body by means of biophotons.

The author writes using scientific references and formulas here and there yet keeps the reader driven to understand every word and to discover more of what is being presented. It is a fascinating look at reality, our place in it and where we are heading as a species.


